Honor Flight Planning for Resumption of Flights

The Board of Honor Flight of the Quad Cities and its many volunteers have put in motion the first steps to resuming flights to Washington DC. The initial plans are for flights for those veterans who served sometime during WWII, Korea, and Viet Nam conflicts.

Although the exact dates are not yet available, they will be announced as soon as possible. It is hoped that flights will begin sometime during the fall of 2021.

When the final "green light" is given for the 51st Honor Flight, Veterans and Guardians who are eligible will be contacted by phone. Further instructions will then be given. Honor flight will provide masks and hand sanitizer for each flight. It is hoped that all Veterans and Guardians will have been immunized by the resumption of flights.
